

We ensure you that there will be a fair play and maximum transparency, and hope you have a wonderful and enjoyable time together with all the other members of the larger community.





- Team registrations for U16 will be via individual Jamaat clubs who will collect team fees from participants and submit to COEJ as one payment
- 16+ playing football will only pay £10 if they are playing netball
- 8 max per team in InterNetball
- The above fees cover meals and snacks throughout the day
- In the event of cancellation, the cost is non-refundable.



FOOTBALL 16+





Football (16+)

Open to: Ladies 16+ (U16 advanced youth are allowed to play at jamaat club discretion. Strictly no one under 15 allowed to play in the ladies event). All abilities are welcome.

£20 per player per team (up to a maximum of 10 players per team). Those playing netball as well will pay £10 for football 7 a side format on Astro.

Registration is on a team basis therefore one member of the team must register the whole team.

You will require full names, email addresses and contact numbers for all of your team members in order to complete the registration form.

We will then calculate the fee for each team based on how many football/netball players there are in the team and pass this information to the captain who must then collect the fees from their team players and submit to COEJ.

We will then email individual team members at a later date requesting more specific information.

Players may only play for one football team throughout the tournament and cannot play for more than one team even if they are from the same Jamaat.

Football (U16)

5 a side format (indoors) for 7-9 years (max 8 in a team) 7 a side format for 10-12 years and 13-15 years (max 10 in a team) on Astro.

Players may only play for one U16 football team throughout the tournament and cannot play for more than one U16 team even if they are from the same Jamaat.

Advanced youth - 15 year olds can play in the U16 and 16+ event at the discretion of their jamaat sports bodies

IMPORTANT INFORMATION





GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation)

- As you are all aware that General Data Protection Regulation ('GDPR') is now in force and we must demonstrate care when dealing with personal data.
- It is expected that all sports bodies submitting entries are aware of the law and have acquired appropriate consent to hold individual Data, such email, DOB, mobile phones that has been subsequently passed onto MAMT Committee.
- Unless informed otherwise MAMT committee will hold personal data securely for a maximum of one month after the Tournament, after which all personal data will be deleted.



- IMPORTANT PENALTY CHARGE NOTICE FOR LATE ENTRIES
- Please note there will be a strict penalty placed upon any Jamaat who does not submit their entries by the agreed date.
- We ask all participants and Jamaats to work together to ensure that this deadline is met promptly.





RULES & REGULATIONS





General Rules and Regulations

- All entries and payments to be submitted by the deadline.
- Behaviour deemed 'unfit' or 'un-Islamic' will not be tolerated. Any gross misconduct or swearing will be severely dealt with by the disciplinary committee.
- CoEJ and/or the relevant hosting Jamaat will not be responsible/liable for any mental or physical trauma to participants and their belongings.
- All teams will have to nominate a team manager/coordinator and they will be the only people to raise any queries with the organizing committee.
- Under no circumstances will a player be allowed to play for more than 1 team in the same sport.
- Any player representing a team for a particular age will not be allowed to play the same sport for a different age group example playing under 12, cannot play under 15, any exceptions will be informed well in advance. U16 players can play in 16+ events at the discretion of their jamaat club.
- Participant application forms include parental consent and disclaimers which now include consent to take photographs of under 16s for the purposes of producing sporting action photos and promoting future COEJ Sports events.
- The starting date of the tournament will be used to determine the age of the participants. Any player, entering the wrong age category will be disqualified.
- It will be the team manager/coordinator who will be responsible for registration and ensure teams arrive on time, arriving late on the day shall be penalized as per the rules in their respective sport.
- Two small Jamaats will be able to merge and submit a team to participate in the tournament.
- Borrowing of players must be cleared by respective Jamaats and the MAMT committee and follow the supplement rules for the sport in question.
- MAMT committee will apply a fair method to assign allocation of teams in case of high volume of teams from a single jamaat.
- Participants taking part in swimming do so at their own risk. CoEJ & organising committee does not accept liability for injuries.
- Any person using or visiting sports facilities which have been arranged by CoEJ & organising committee does so at their own risk. CoEJ & organising committee does not accept any liability for injury incurred by participating in any sporting activities, either on/off the pitch or whilst spectating. CoEJ & organising committee does not accept liability for any damage to or loss of personal belongings of either participants or spectators whether during the allocated period of play or where belongings are left in changing rooms or on site.











Criteria Rules

- Finally, please note that the qualification criteria for participating is based on each individual Jamaat's sports body membership criteria as long as they are of the Shia Ithna Asheri faith.
- It is the responsibility of Jamaat sports co-ordinators and team captains to ensure participants meet all the required criteria.
- Violation of the rules could result in entire teams being disqualified.
- Any rules not covered by this document shall be at the discretion of the MAMT committee and their decision will be final and binding.
